2. Select the evaluation area (there are different levels for each area)
3. Insert ISSN number
4. Click in “CONSULTAR”

The impact of the paper published will be displayed in the box “CLASSIFICAÇÃO” – It ranges from “A1” (high impact) to “C” (low impact)
